Family Promise - Greater Phoenix provides a community response for families who are homeless. This is a nonprofit, 501(c)3 organization, and the Federal Tax Number is 86-0914408. As such all material and monetary donations are tax deductible.

Nationwide, families are the fastest growing segment of the homeless population. Half of the homeless are women and children under six years of age. Arizona's statistics are consistent with those nationally! Lower income families often live from paycheck to paycheck. Major illnesses, poor economic times, job loss, or other forces beyond their control can drive the low to middle-income working people into homelessness.

Our network is unique in that it uses the facilities and volunteers of many faith-based and religious congregations in the greater Phoenix area to provide temporary shelter and meals for families who are homeless and in transition to once again becoming self-supporting.

Through the course of the next year, the organizations working with Family Promise will be purchasing many different items in order to act on their faith and provide hospitality to the families.
